2. BACKGROUND

The Department of Social Development has standardised on and operates HPE Core Networking

equipment which has been successfully deployed and is utilised extensively in the daily function

of the department. As the equipment serves such a vital role and is so strategically deployed to

key operational areas, it has been realised that the equipment must be maintained at the highest

levels to minimise the possibility of fault or failure of the equipment. The Core equipment is due

4. SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The selected supplier will be expected to:

- 4.1 Provide the department with total pricing of the entire solution. Hidden costs will not be entertained.
- 4.2 To enter into a five (5) year support and maintenance SLA that adheres to the listed severity level response times.
- 4.3 Provide proof of HPE partner accreditation or certification in enterprise network environment.
- 4.4 Provide a response pricing that must remain fixed for 90 days.
- 4.5 The decision whether to appoint or not appoint a successful applicant, based on the responses to this request, lies solely with the Department of Social Development.
- 4.6 You are required to disclose any partnership for the duration of this project and provide proof of certification for the work they will be involved in.
- 4.7 The OEM warranty will be paid up-front and in total as part of the first payment at the onset of the engagement.
- 4.8 The SLA will be paid in five (5) annual payments. Each payment will be made at the beginning of the year of service for the duration of the SLA.

5 EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 5. 1 The evaluation of the bids will be conducted in two stages:
- a) Firstly, the proposals will be evaluated on functionality. An evaluation panel will allocate points (scale 0-5) in respect of functionality according to the criteria set-up in paragraph 5.6 proposals scoring less than 70% in respect of functionality will be disqualified and not be evaluated further.
- b) Thereafter, only the qualifying bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points system as contemplated in the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017 issued in terms of Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000).
