APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO DEVELOP AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM TO COLLECT DATA ON SUBSTANCE USE AND MEASURE THE PERFORMANCE AND QUALITY OF SOUTH AFRICA'S SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT SERVICES

1. PURPOSE

To appoint a service provider for the development of an electronic system to collect data on substance use and measure the performance and quality of South Africa's substance use treatment services.

2. PROJECT NAME

Substance Abuse System (Acronym of the project SAS)

3. BACKGROUND

Untreated substance use is a major driver of crime and violence in South Africa. Providing people who use substances with access to effective treatment may be an important crime prevention and family's preservation strategy. Addressing the burden associated with substance use disorders (SUDs) is both a global and national priority, as reflected in the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals for 2030, where SUD prevention and treatment are included in the targets. Several efforts have been undertaken to improve the quality of SUD treatment in South Africa, such as training on evidence-based treatment through the Colombo Plan Programme (Universal Treatment Curriculum). However, there is still minimum monitoring of the quality and outcomes of SUD services, as a result the impact of these services remains uncertain. Without good data on the quality of SUD treatment, service improvement efforts in South Africa may be poorly targeted and have limited effect.

These data are also needed to advocate for greater investment in SUD prevention, treatment and continuing care services. The Department of Social Development as a lead Department in the field of substance abuse is also expected to submit annually epidemiology reports covering trends in substance use and abuse, impact and services to the African Union Commission and the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime. As such the development of an electronic system to collect data on substance use and

measure the performance and quality of South Africa's substance use services is essential.

DSD intends to develop SAS to enable the information exchange with other stakeholders (public sector and private sector). DSD has an integrated case management solution called Social Development Integrated Case Management System (SDICMS) which is built on Microsoft ASP.NET and database based on SQL 2008 R2. SAS is expected to be part of SDICMS.

4. SCOPE OF WORK
