TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO ASSIST WITH THE TRANSFER OF RECORDS TO OFFSITE STORAGE FACILITY FOR THE DSD FOR A PERIOD OF SIXTY (60) MONTHS PERIOD (FIVE (5) YEARS)

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of the assignment is to appoint Records Management Service Provider to provide Off-Site Storage facility, Retrieval and Delivery services and to render Records Management services for DSD in line with the provisions of the National Archives Records Services Act, 1996 (Act no. 43 of 1996 as amended) for a period of sixty (60) months Fifty Four.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. DSD does not have sufficient space and proper records storage facility in line with the guidelines from National Archives.
- On a daily basis DSD generates manual case files amongst others for Adoptions, Non-Profit Organization, Appeals, and Internal Control, etc.
- 2.3. These files are critical and support the administrative and legislative functions of the DSD.
- 2.4. The records are retrieved on a daily basis in order to support administrative and legislative work of various programmes within the DSD.

3. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

- 3.1. The scope of work is for period of sixty (60) months (five years) to render Records Management services as follows:
- 3.2. Sorting and packaging of records in boxes
- 3.3. Labelling and indexing services when records are captured.
- 3.4. Storing boxes of records (size of box 250x430x325mm containing 10 files per box).
- 3.5. Off-site storage and On-site File Management.
- 3.6. Retrieval of records.
- 3.7. Delivery of records from DSD to Off-site Storage Facility vice versa.
- 3.8. Transfer of records from the DSD to the Off-Site Storage facility and back in a secure transport/delivery facilities when the need arises.
- 3.9. Turnaround time for delivery of retrieved records should be within 24 hours.



4. DELIVERABLES

- 4.1. The successful bidder is required to provide Off-site Storage facilities and to render records Management services for DSD in line with the provisions of the National Archives and Records Services Act, 1996 (Act no. 43 of 1996 as amended) for a period of sixty (months).
- 4.2. Records Management services required, amongst other things includes, Onsite File Management, Paper Management, Labelling and Indexing of boxes.
- 4.3. The Service Provider must return the records to the DSD upon expiry of the contract.
- 4.4. The service provider will be requested to remove the records and package them from the current service provider.
- 4.5. Service provider must provide boxes for records packaging.

5. REQUIREMENTS

5.1. Functional requirement

- 5.1.1. The off-site storage facilities should be located within 70km radius from DSD or any other facility.
- 5.1.2. The off-site storage facilities should be accommodated in a secure, access controlled systems site which is protected with electric fencing and is patrolled 24/7.
- 5.1.3. The storage facilities should be equipped with climate controlled facilities which can prevent degradation of records e.g. adequate ventilation and humidity control as well as pest and rodents control.
- 5.1.4. The storage facilities should comply with Occupational Health and Safety Standards (have fire prevention facilities that include Sprinkler Systems, Smoke Detectors and relevant fire extinguishers).
- 5.1.5. The service provider must have a minimum of five years' experience in providing Off-site Storage and Records Management Services in the public sector environment.
- 5.1.6. The service provider must submit a minimum of five (5) reference letters from their clients (preferably government departments) which specify the type of service procured, period of contract, i.e. start date and end date. Letters must be on the company or Departmental letter head and must be signed by the Responsible Records Manager, dated and including contactable details.
- 5.1.7. The Service Provider must provide for unscheduled collection and return of records in an emergency situation.
- 5.1.8. Failure to attach certified copies on the above-requirements, bidders will forfeit points



5.2 Security Clearance and Confidentiality Requirements

- 5.2.1 DSD reserves the right to conduct another security clearance for selected bidders and service providers required to attach copies of their company profile and copies of the ID/Passport of the Directors of the company for security clearance purpose.
- 5.2.2 Service Providers must attach Security Clearance Certificate in their proposal
- 5.2.3 Appointment of the successful bidder will be subject to positive Security Clearance.
