Terms of Reference for the appointment of a digital agency to conceptualise, design, develop and customize a digital booklet on the extension of social security to informal sector workers for DSD internal and public platforms.

May 2021



1. Purpose

To appoint a digital agency to conceptualise, design, develop and customize a digital booklet on the extension of social security to informal sector workers.

2. Project Name

Development of interactive communication material on the extension of social security to informal sector workers.

3. Background

In November 2016, the Minister of Social Development tabled a comprehensive social security (CSS) discussion paper to the National Economic Development and Labour Council (NEDLAC). The paper was prepared by an Interdepartmental Task Team (IDTT) on Comprehensive Social Security and Retirement Reform. Key proposals include: establishment of a mandatory national social security fund; expansion of social assistance; enhancement of social insurance funds; regulatory reforms for the pensions and life insurance industry; strengthen the links between social security and labour; improvement of unemployment benefits; and alignment of social security with National Health Insurance.

As a part of the comprehensive social security reform, there is consensus on the need to extend social security cover to informal sector workers and self-employed/ atypical workers. Furthermore, the administration of that fund will be of low cost and should be designed for the benefit members of such an arrangement.

Since completing the feasibility and technical studies, the Directorate: Retirement Reform continues to engage stakeholders working in the sector to solicit further inputs. These inputs are critical in the refinement of the policy proposal on social security coverage to informal sector workers.



4. Motivation

From the interactive focus group discussions, it was observed that most members in the informal sector have limited understanding of retirement and pension issues, especially the contributory social insurance system. The content that is shared with stakeholders in the sector is highly technical and in most instances, participants find it difficult to comprehend the content and hence the need to simplify with illustrations that they can easily relate to. In some instances, participants end up defaulting to raising issues not related to the topic being addressed.

Due to the technical nature of the studies and proposals presented and lack of and/or limited understanding of the issues by the informal sector workers, this project seeks to ensure that the content is simplified and presented in audio and visual formats that stakeholders can easily relate to. This will ensure that stakeholders will provide relevant feedback and comments during and after consultative sessions. This will assist the Directorate in improving the communication of the key messages on the key proposals and trigger robust conversations with stakeholders. Such feedback will strengthen policy proposals under consideration.

It is against this background that the Directorate seeks to appoint a digital agency to conceptualise, design, develop and customize a digital booklet on the extension of social security to informal sector workers.

Scope of the work.

The scope of the work to conceptualise, design, develop and customize a digital booklet will be as follows:

- +/- 15 pages digital booklet on the extension of social security to the informal sector workers in 6 languages – English, Afrikaans, Zulu, Sotho, Venda and Tsonga.
- Digital booklet should be created with digital page turning software.
- Customised for digital and social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Website, and WhatsApp).
- Design, develop, layout, edit copy. A printable copy will be required and service provider to print 500 copies for distribution.



- Instructions to include infographic diagrams and gifs to visually simplify the content.
- 6 x 3 minute animated instruction videos to be incorporated into the digital booklet – these should be created in each of the languages above and must cater for the deaf in the form of subtitles.
- Voice over artists' fee should over minimum six months usage and booklet content will be published on internal and public platforms.

The Department of Social Development will provide the content for production.

6. Deliverables

The service provider will deliver:

- The digital booklet including infographic diagrams and gifs to simplify the content.
- Printable copy 500 printed copies for delivery to one location.
- Animated instruction videos (also incorporated in the digital booklet).
- Print ready design files should be supplied to the Department on USB.

7. Assumptions

The Department of Social Development co-operates and is available as planned.

Communication channel between the service provider and the Department of Social Development is open and constructive.

The service provider is also expected to illustrate the working or functionality of the material presented to DSD.

8. Time frames

The service provider is expected to finalise and handover all the deliverables to the project within 3 months from signing the contract. The preferred service provider will be expected to meet with the Department to set out the specific work requirements and give clarity to the Department concerning expected deliverables.



9. Skills, knowledge and experience required

The team contained in the proposal must be available for the duration of the project. Replacement of team members may only be done in consultation with DSD and replacement team members must have the same qualifications, skills and experience as those they are replacing.

The service provider must have:

- Experience in graphic design especially involving creation and communication of ideas through visual concepts in both digital platform and by hand;
- Experience in voice over production process including audio visual electronic media processing both in sound and visual component;
- Experience in script/copywriting, editing and layout of cinematographic content;
- Experience in creating advertisements in television and radio; and
- Experience in acting and ability to engage with audience, memorise lines and understand a character;
- Experience in working on Governments and Corporate campaigns;
- Experience in setting visual content to sign language interpretation and
- Ability to translate/communicate content in South African official languages.

Bid proposal

The bidder include the following:

- A response to the terms of reference;
- A project plan that states the methodology and approach for accomplishing the task, project phases if applicable, time frames and outputs (excluding cost for the project);
- Profile of the organisation and description of similar work undertaken;
- Number, names and CVs of workers/consultants assigned to the project, including their roles and responsibilities, experience on issues relating to DSD sector;
- Letter of authority to sign documents on behalf of the organisation;



- The cost structure should be inclusive and as detailed as possible.
- The service provider is expected to enter into a contract with DSD based on the proposal.
- A work plan indicating time frames should be provided with the proposal.
- Progress will be monitored monthly based on the work plan and time frames provided by the service approved by the DSD.

11. Equipment

The service provider is required to furnish their own equipment for the period of the contract.

12. Proprietary rights

- 12.1. The DSD shall become the owner of the information, documents, advice and reports collected and compiled by the service provider to be appointed.
- 12.2. The copyrights of all documents and reports compiled by the service provider will vest in the DSD and may not be produced, distributed or made available without the consent and approval of the DSD.
- All information, documents and reports must be regarded as confidential until made public by the DSD.

13. Evaluation criteria

The evaluation of the bids will be conducted in two (2) stages:

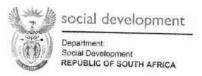
- 13.1. Firstly, the proposals will be evaluated on functionality. An evaluation panel will allocate points (scale 1-5) in respect of functionality according to the criteria set-up in paragraph 13.7 proposals scoring less than 60% in respect of functionality will be disqualified and not be evaluated further.
- 13.2. Thereafter, only the qualifying bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points system as contemplated in the Preference Procurement Regulations 2017 issued in terms of Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000).



- 13.3. The 80 points will be used to calculate points for price only and 20 points will be used to calculate points for BBBEE status levels of contribution (SBD 6.1). Prospective service providers are required to complete the SBD 6.1.
- 13.4. The points in respect of price will be calculated on the ceiling price for the project (inclusive of the professional fees, travel and subsistence cost, as well as VAT).
- 13.5. PLEASE NOTE: SBD 6.1 attached for claiming above-mentioned points, if not completed the bidder will automatically score 0 points.
