# TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT DATA WAREHOUSE AND BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE SOLUTION

#### 1. PURPOSE

To appoint a service provider to develop and implement an end-to-end Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence (DW & BI) solution to enhance evidence based planning and better decision making for the Department of Social Development for a period of twelve (12) months.

#### 2. PROJECT NAME

Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence Solution.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

The department lacks systematic method for central storage and analysis of data. There are silosystems which are programme tailor-made. This poses a challenge and risk for the department. The department is unable to respond to data related queries and thus there is no proper data analysis. The creation of Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence solution will provide a proper solution to address poor data storage and analysis in the department.

#### 4. BUSINESS OBJECTIVES

The main strategic objectives of the project is to develop and implement Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence solution for the Department to:

- Knowledge and experience in configuration and installation of Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence solution.
- Ability to work under pressure and commitment to work on a tight time frame.
- Project management skills.
- Good communication skills.
- Service provider must be certified by Microsoft for proving up to date Microsoft technology-based solutions.

#### 8. SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

- Development and implementation of Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence tools/solutions.
- Experience in Microsoft data warehouse technologies.

#### 9. GENERAL CONDITIONS

The general conditions of contract as prescribed by National Treasury will be applicable in all instances.

#### 10. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Department will enter into a contract/service level agreement with the successful/appointed service provider.

The Department reserves the right not to appoint the service provider should it deem fit to do so.

The successful service provider will be required to undergo security clearance should the Department deem it necessary.

The successful service provider shall not cede the contract or any part thereof to any other person or third party. The successful/appointed service provider will therefore remain the sole responsibility agent for the project as a whole.

The department will furnish the successful/appointed service provider with all the relevant information and available data within their possession that may be necessary for the service provider to perform duties.

All information, documents, and reports not currently in public domain and used during the development of the system or generated from the project must be regarded as confidential and may not be made available to any unauthorized person or institution without permission of the Accounting Officer or delegate.

The Department will become the owner of all information, documents, reports and advice collected and compiled during the execution of the project.

Copyright of all documents and reports generated will vest in Department and may not be reproduced, distributed or made available in any manner to public or third parties without written permission of the Accounting Officer or delegate.

#### 11. TIME FRAMES

The project is planned to be conducted over a period of twelve (12) months.

#### 12. REPORTING ARRANGEMENT

All deliverables should be submitted to the department. Any deliverables submitted and not accepted must be reworked and resubmitted at no additional cost.

The service provider will provide overall Project Manager.

A comprehensive bi-monthly report will be submitted by the service provider to the Data Warehouse Project Management Team.

#### 13. SUB-CONTRACTING ARRANGEMENTS

The Department reserves the right to approve the consultants/sub-contractors offered by the service provider. The replacement of consultants/sub-contractors during the contract period must be approved by the Department.

#### 14. JOINT VENTURES/CONSORTIUMS

The Department requires the following information in cases where two or more bidders form a joint venture/consortium:

- An agreement between the service providers that clearly states who will be the leading company and the portion of work to be executed by each service provider.
- An original and valid Tax Clearance Certificate for each service provider.
- A joint B-BBEE certificate (refer to SBD6.1 Bidding Form).
- Completed and signed SBD4, SBD8 & SBD9 bidding forms for each service provider.

#### 15. BID PROPOSAL

The comprehensive proposal submission should include:

- A detailed plan reflecting project time frames, costing and outputs/deliverables.

An evaluation panel will allocate points (scale 1-5) in respect of functionality according to the criteria set-up below in Table.1 Evaluation Matrix proposals scoring less than 65 points in respect of functionality will be disqualified and not be evaluated further.
- Thereafter, only the qualifying bids will be evaluated in terms of 80/20 preference points system as contemplated in the Preference Procurement Regulations 2017 issued in terms of Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000).

The 80 points will be used to calculate points for price only and 20 points will be used to calculate points for BBBEE status levels of contribution (SBD 6.1).

The points in respect of price will be calculated on the ceiling price for the project inclusive of the professional fees), as well as VAT).
